



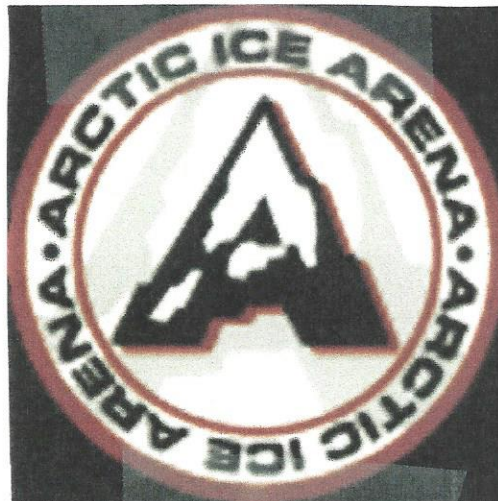

Registration

Registration is open and is in person only. Please register at Arctic Ice Arena front desk. Prior to registration you must obtain your skater's current USA Hockey confirmation number. Visit www.usahockey.com to get your 2017-2018 USA Hockey confirmation.

Fees

\$1400 - (240 minutes of ice per week, 7 months of Hockey development) Fees include: all home practices, powerskates and jamborees, 2 game jerseys and pair of socks. Pay in full -> receive \$100 discount. If not paying in full, \$300 registration fee is due. The payment plan entails four additional payments (15th of September, October, November, & December) for each skater registered.

Details

Jr. Fury Silver Minor Mites is offered to young skaters born from 2012-2009 with minimal skating experience. These skaters are either too young or not developmentally ready to play Major Mite. Silver Minor Mites practice twice a week on the weekends (90 min slots) and powerskate on Friday nights. Compete in cross ice jamborees against similar programs from neighboring rinks.

Purpose

To improve all youth hockey - player's ability, balance, and coordination in a positive environment for maximum physical and psychological growth. We use USA Hockey's ADM model of development and divide the 90 minutes of ice time into two 45 minute programs. First 45 minutes - skill development. Second 45 minutes - 3 vs 3 cross ice hockey game.

Schedule

Sept. 9 2017 – March 11, 2018 (7 month season length)

Friday powerskate: 6:00pm – 6:50pm

Sat/Sun practices: 12:50pm – 2:20pm (90 mins)

Jamborees and annual events TBD

Teams are formed based on parity regardless of age.

Practice and powerskate times will be consistent

Eligibility

- Boys and girls born 2012-2009
- Must be in or have graduated from Introduction to Hockey Program
- Cannot currently be rostered on a hockey team or in a hockey league

Equipment

Full equipment is required of all skaters which includes hockey skates, shin guards, hockey socks, pants, shoulder and elbow pads, hockey helmet with cage, hockey stick, neck guard, and practice jersey
